Dear Mr. Revilak:

I have received your email dated November 16, 2014 requesting copies of letters sent to the Office of the Attorney General (AGO). Specifically, you requested "Copies of all notification letters sent to the Attorney General under 950 CMR 32.09 (Enforcement of Orders), during the period January 1, 2014 through June 30, 2014".

The Public Records Law strongly favors disclosure by creating a presumption that all governmental records are public records. G. L. c. 66, § 10(c); 950 C.M.R. 32.08(4). "Public records" is broadly defined to include all documentary materials or data, regardless of physical form or characteristics, made or received by any officer or employee of any town of the Commonwealth, unless falling within a statutory exemption. G. L. c. 66, § 7(26).

Subsequent to a review of our files there are no records responsive to your request.
