#### **Basics: What is FOIA**

- Freedom of Information Act specific thing, general meaning
- Federal (FOIA), State and Local (State Public Records Law FOIL, OPRA, Etc.)
- Basic gist records generated by government are public records, and therefore belong to the public

## Super-Brief History

- LBJ signed FOIA into law in 1966, after a decade of pesteri by CA Rep. John Moss
- Not originally related to Watergate, but Privacy Act amendment of 1974 was, and gave it the scope it currently has
- States followed suit with own variations

## What Kind of Records Are We Talking About?

- Forms, Manuals, Policy, etc.
- Letters, Memos, Emails
- Source Code, Websites, Metadata
- Processing notes for requests

#### What CAN'T You Get

- Personal Info SSN, Medical Records, etc.
- Want somebody's FBI file? Ask their permission, or wait till they're dead
- No national security secrets, or anything that would "put people at risk"
- Also, wells

### **Caveat Requestor**

- Ironically, the Freedom of Information Act is not free MBTA is especially bad about this
- Delays State Department takes years,
  USMS' busted hard drive
- Redactions/Sanitation Sobering/Snowden/ Snackcar

#### Who Uses FOIA?

- Commercial (Patents, Personal data) 95%
- Journalists/Researchers 4%
- Everybody Else 1%

#### Who Should?

- You, obviously
- Activists ARIC docs
- Bodycams, Stingrays, Spotshotters
- You're being watched might as well know what they're looking at
